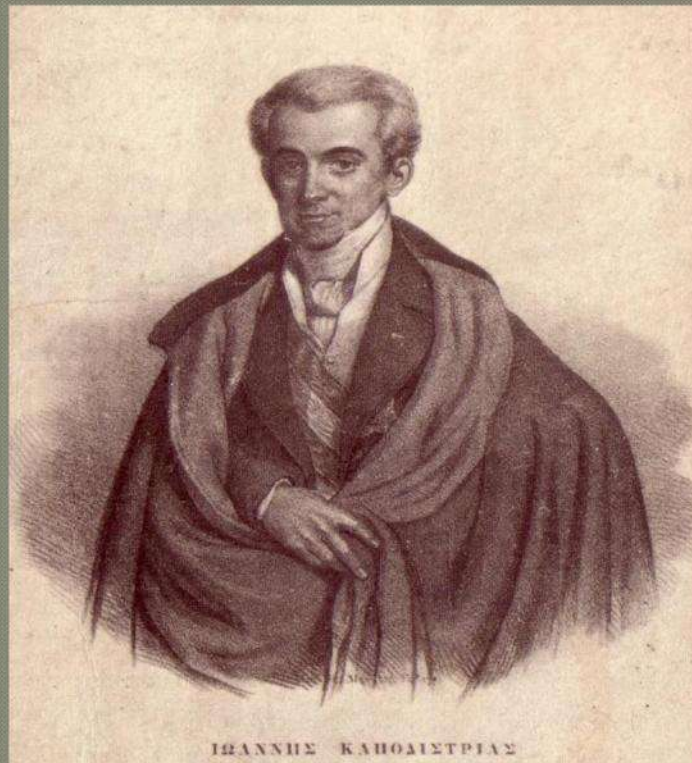

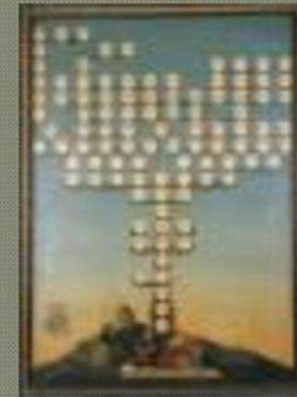

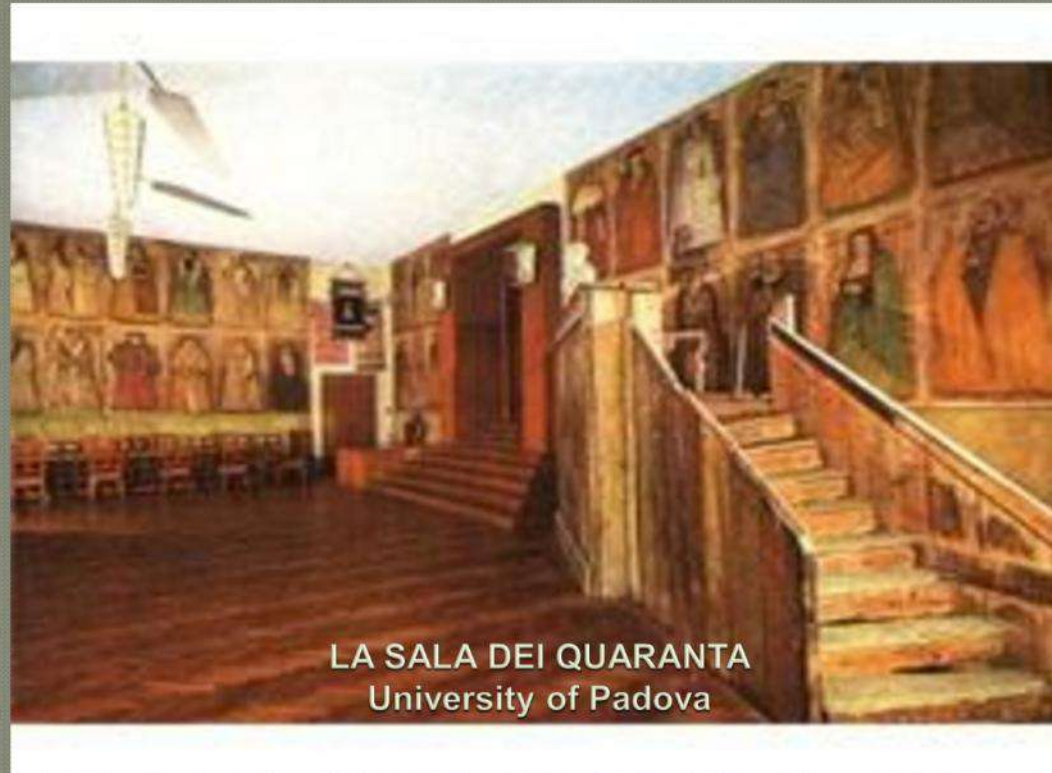

## **Major stages of his political career**

**1801: Septinsular Republic administration (Ionian State)**

**1809: Russian Diplomatic Corps**

**1813: Special Envoy of the Russian Czar to Switzerland**

**1815: Participation to the Vienna and Paris Congresses as Russian diplomat**

**1816-1822: Co-Minister of Foreign Affairs**

**1828: Governor of Greece**

# SEPTINSULAR REPUBLIC (1800-1807)

---

- Head of Corfu Hospital's Medical Service
- Special Envoy to Cefalonia (public order – rebels)
- Secretary of State (Foreign Office)
- Inspector of Education (first public school – Tenedos)
- Special Envoy to Lefkas (Turks – local mainland chiefs)

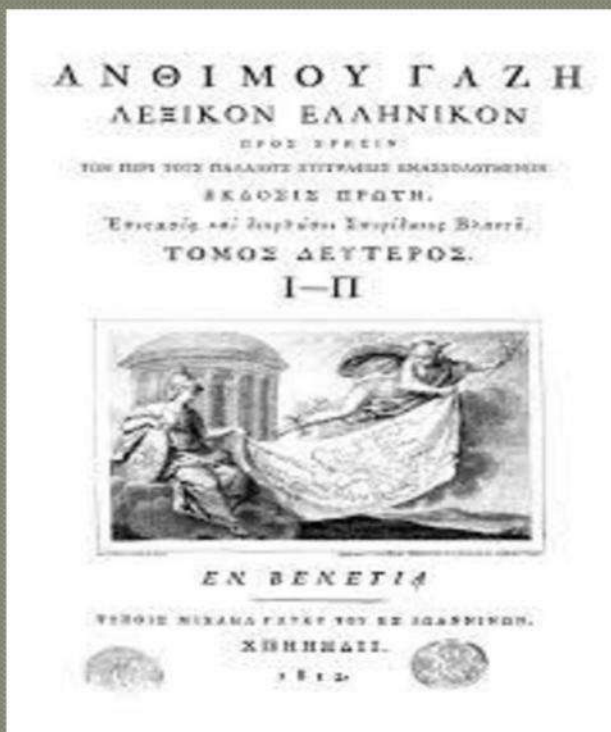

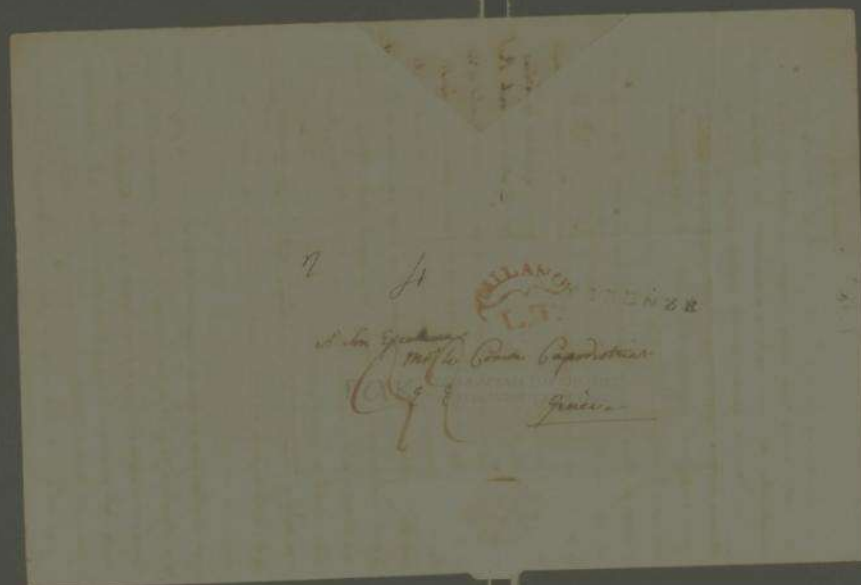

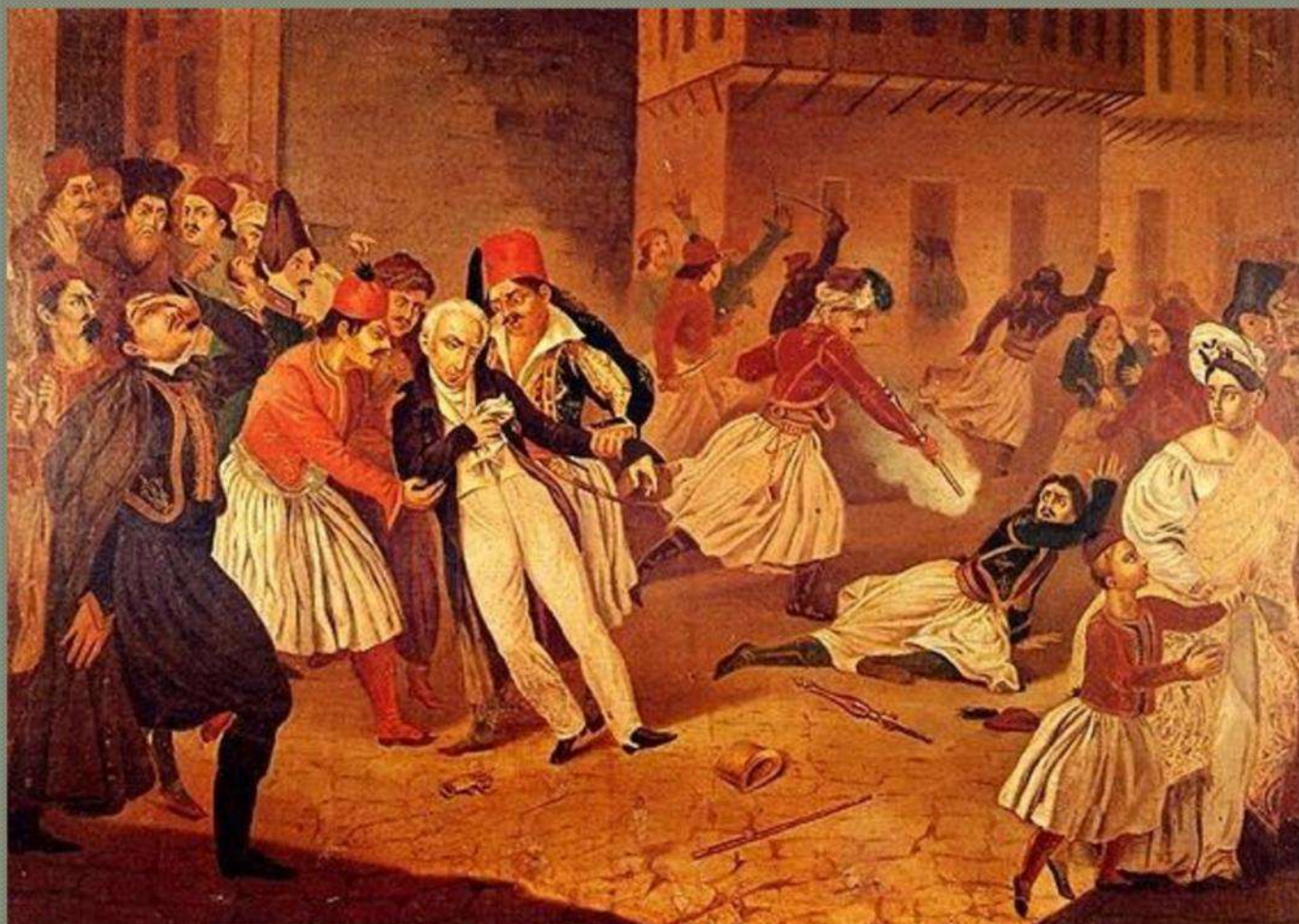
